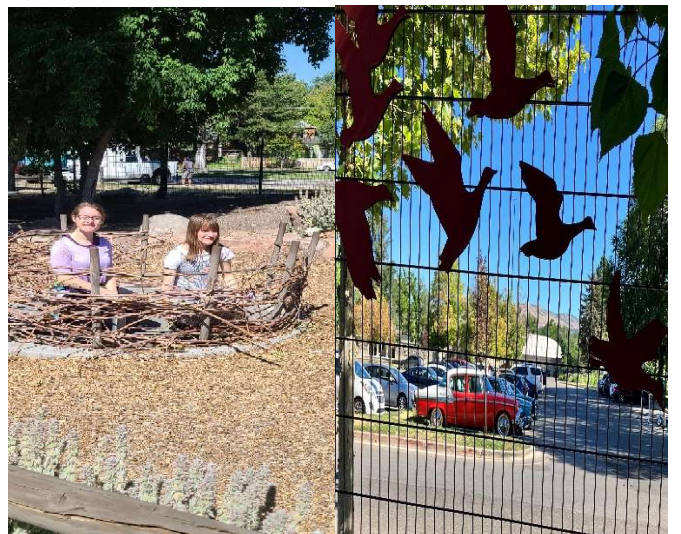
Tracy Aviary

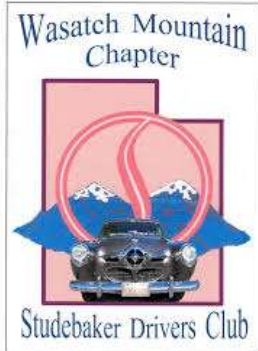
