Sponsor dues are also being accepted. They are \$20 for the year. We are always looking for new sponsors, if you have any leads.

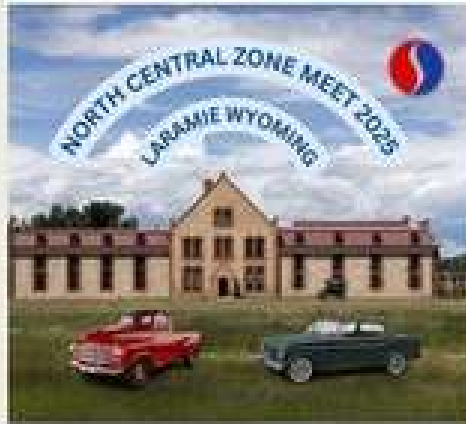
