April 27, 2024 Vietnam Memorial Wall

Our dust off saw an Oldsmobile, Toyota, Hyundai, Nissan, Chevrolet and 2 Dodges all getting a mother nature car wash due to the rainy weather. We met up at the Chevron Station in Wood Cross and caravanned to the Vietnam Veteran Memorial Wall in Layton.

Upon arriving we were greeted by our tour guide, Dennis Howland, and his three helpers and two dogs. The wall is an 85% replica of the wall in Washington, DC. There are 53,317 names on the wall, which includes 366 names from Utah. There are eight names of women on the wall, which are additionally memorialized by plaques on eight benches surrounding the wall. There is also a memorial that represents over 5,000 dogs that served. Utah is the 7th State to recognize March 13th as K9 Veterans Day. Afterwards we all went to Burger Stop for lunch. Everyone had a great time and enjoyed their food.
